

## sermon study notes

#### Honouring the Lord Jesus at Home and at Work (Ephesians 6:1-9)

#### **Introduction**:

If we are going to "walk in wisdom" (Eph 5:15) and "redeem the time" (Eph 5:16) and "do God's will" (Eph 5:17) and "be filled with the Holy Spirit" (Eph 5:18) in our family relationships, and in our jobs in the workplace - then we must put into practice the teaching of Ephesians ch.6, v.1-9.

These instructions for children, fathers, slaves and masters not only show us "how to live," but they also provide us with gracious, Christ-centered reasons for daily living.

#### Sermon Outline:

As wise, Spirit-filled believers in Jesus Christ:

- 1. We are called to be obedient & respectful towards those who are in authority over us.
  - Children, obey your parents in the Lord... (v.1-3)
  - Slaves, obey your masters... as serving the Lord... (v.5-8)

See also Matthew 6:1-18; 10:42; 16:27; Hebrews 11:6

- \*Christian obedience comes from faith in God, looking forward to God's reward.
- 2. We are called to use our authority carefully, according to God's own character.
  - Fathers, do not exasperate, but bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord (v.4)
  - Masters, in the same way, do not threaten... (v.9)
    - \*We should only lead others with graciousness and respect, according to Jesus' own character.
