Search Team Update

The Search Team has completed their initial review of the information received from the congregational survey, Lead Pastor exit interview and staff interviews. The Ministry Leaders Survey is now complete and information received from this survey will be reviewed and discussed at the next Search Team meeting on June 11.

Relevant information from all of these sources is being used to shape the job description for the next Lead Pastor. This job description will be presented to the Board for their approval at the next Board meeting on June 18. Once the Board has approved the job description, the Search Team will prepare a job posting for appropriate sites (NABC, CCCC, others TBD).

The Search Team will provide summaries of findings and recommendations from the interviews and surveys to the Board and Staff. They, in turn, will consider the feedback they contain, come to their own conclusions on issues related to governance and ministry, and will be free to share their thoughts and conclusions with the congregation.
